Guidance



Administer calcium early.

- Give IV/IO calcium during or immediately after first unit of blood to all hemorrhagic shock patients, and then again after every four units
- Monitor ionized calcium to prevent hypocalcemia related to massive transfusion

Do NOT administer...

- Hydroxyethyl starch (**Hextend, Hespan**)
- Recombinant human activated factor VII (**rhFVIIa**)
